2024 Delano Kindred Annual Meeting and Reunion in Maggie Valley, NC

The Delano Kindred held another very successful annual meeting/reunion in Maggie Valley, NC. This year we teamed up with the Soule Kindred on many of the activities. Overall we have approximately 60 attendees with about 40 from the Delano Kindred and about 20 from the Soule Kindred. There are many photos from this meeting, so I will organize them by day, beginning with **Thursday, Sept.12**.

The big event on Thursday was the visit to Delano, Tennessee for a 4 hour train ride through the Great Smokey Mountains followed by a dinner at the Savannah Oaks Winery in Delano.

On **Friday, Sept. 13th**, we began the day with breakfast, then registration, and then a brief Delano Kindred board of directors meeting. Once the board meeting was over we then all drove to Asheville, NC to tour the Biltmore Estate.
